



Plan your work flow and installation steps by following thoroughly the following instructions and additional information from our website. It is possible to finish installation in a single day and start enjoying your masterpiece the following day-proper planning is key!

- 30 minutes Surface Prep
- 1 hour Base Coat + Flakes
- 4-6 hours Curing time
 - 30 minutes Clear coat
- Overnight curing
- Start using the following day!

STEP. 01 PLAN & SURFACE PREP

A Good surface prep is the foundation to achieving a long-lasting ALLEGAN-TILE application. Properly preparing the surface before painting ensures that the coatings adheres well



R Use the sanding block provided to sand along tile grouts and existing tile or surfaces to remove accumulated dirt, dust, soap scum and etc.

STEP, 02 BASE COAT + FLAKES *for Classic 660 only

This will be your first attempt using the paint from our kit. Follow our guide to ensure a flawless finish.

- A. Shake the can of Base Coat for 5 seconds to ensure homogenous mix.
- C. Using the roller, start painting from the furthest corner away from the exit



- B. Empty entire can of base coat into the tray provided.
- D. Use long strokes in a W pattern for ample coverage.

STEP, 02 FLAKES INSTALLATION *for Classic 660 only

This will be your first attempt using the paint from our kit. Follow our guide to ensure a flawless finish.

- E. When you are half-way. pause to install the ALLEGAN Flakes component on top of the Base Coat surface
- F. Sprinkle the flakes manually by hand in a spraying motion.

- G Repeat above steps to finish the second half of area.
- H. When done, leave paint to dry for at least 4 hours (up to 6 hours depending on room conditions).

STEP.03 **CLEAR COAT**

A final step to provide a wearing and protective layer over earlier base coat and flakes (for Classic 660 only). Additionally, it enhances the surface with a clean and brand new glossy finish.



Allow clear coat to dry overnight before using the floor or painted surface.
