WHO WE ARE

Education Choice is a group of parents and educators concerned with providing support to those families that have chosen to open micro schools and homeschools in Minnesota. Given the changing landscape of education choice, we are committed to provide information and resources so that parent home-educators can offer safe, effective and successful educational opportunities for their children.



Ensure that as many boys and girls as possible can access classical academic education:

- Using methods grounded in objective reality and deductive reasoning,
- in a setting-that honors our Judeo/Christian heritage as the external measure of right and wrong and the basis of our ability to civilly live and work together as a self-governing people in our republic; and
- socializes students with an emphasis on family, faith and community.

Assist home school co-ops and micro schools to collaborate with one another.

Create a pool of human and other resources, available on a volunteer basis to support home schooling and micro schools in Minnesota.



Academics: Students must achieve mastery of academic basics, especially grade-level reading and math. Public schools are not prioritizing this.

Values: Parents must be able to trust that their children will not be indoctrinated in now mainstream subjective reality worldviews and progressive beliefs, especially Woke race and sexual dogma. Learning will be grounded in classical objective reality and deductive reasoning methods creating Woke-resistant boys and girls.

Working with "work": Two -income, working families have work structures to accommodate; many need inexpensive work-time child care as well as supplemental support for home-schooling.

WHAT WE DO:
