FULL DAY SAMARIA GORGE TOUR (INTERMEDIATE)

Experience authentic Crete on this 16 km trek of the Samaria Gorge. Various route options are available, including a visit to the picturesque coastal village of Sougia or the hidden archaeological site of Lisso. Suggested start time 07:30. *Private Activity | Duration: 9 hours*
