Getting there




Getting to Australia

Australia has an enviably long list of options for flights arriving to the country's many international ports which include Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Cairns, Adelaide, Darwin, Canberra and Perth. Please check with your travel advisor for flight schedules.

Getting to New Zealand

There are many flight options for arriving into New Zealand's North or South Islands from overseas ports, including of course its closest international neighbour Australia. New Zealand's international ports include its capital Wellington, Auckland, Christchurch and Queenstown.

For a spectacular aerial arrival, it's hard to beat a helicopter transfer and The Louise has a daylight helipad onsite perfect for the purpose. | For self-drive island excursions, a 45-minute ferry service runs between Cape Jervis on the mainland and Penneshaw on Kangaroo Island, which is 90 minutes drive from the lodge. Cape Jervis is a picturesque two-hour drive from Adelaide. | Luxury transfers from Cairns Airport are available to book in advance. Scenic helicopter flights from Cairns Airport to Port Douglas offer an aerial perspective of the region and are a spectacular start or end to a stay in the Daintree. | Private luxury vehicle transfers from Ayers Rock Airport can be arranged in advance. Self-driving to Uluru is another popular option. Private vehicle access is not available at the property but parking is available offsite and complimentary transfers to and from the lodge can be arranged in advance. | - | Guests on self-drive journeys can expect a three and a half hour road trip from Auckland, a five-hour drive from Wellington or a one-hour drive from Rotorua. 


