Dog Food vs. Recreational THC Edibles



Accidental ingestion of product can lead to serious adverse events including death, especially in children.¹



Addiction develops in 36% of daily users.²



Dosage recommendations are based on rigorous nutritional or pharmacokinetic studies.



Ingredient amounts listed on packaging may be incorrect.³



Product may look like candy or fruit snacks to children.



License requirement to manufacture product.⁴



Chemicals used to make the product may create byproducts that are potentially toxic.



Recreational THC is Unsafe.

Contact your state representatives and tell them to ban all recreational psychoactive chemicals derived from hemp or marijuana.
