Dedicated to exquisite comfort and delight, The Fifth immerses guests in lush interiors by acclaimed designer **Martin Brudnizki**; offers new perspectives through compelling cultural experiences and an extensive art collection; and features remarkable culinary creations at its signature restaurant, Café Carmellini, and the intimate Portrait Bar, both helmed by James Beard Awardwinning chef, Andrew Carmellini.

Housed in a graciously restored landmark building, The Fifth is rooted in the history of New York City while shaping its future.

ROOMS & SUITES

The Fifth Avenue Hotel is comprised of 153 guest rooms, including 43 suites—six with private terraces with views of the Empire State Building, Flatiron Building, NoMad, and Fifth Avenue.

Rooms

Located in the 24-story Tower, 110 guest rooms feature connecting options and customized bedding configurations.

Suites

Café Carmellini

Café Carmellini is the signature restaurant from James Beard Award-winning chef **Andrew Carmellini**. The name Café Carmellini is a nod to the Carmellini family's coffee importing business in Tuscany that thrived for 120 years. Here, Chef Carmellini distills his 30-year career cooking in New York City into an extraordinary dining experience while marking his return to fine dining: his food marries Italian and French cooking to a classic New York feel and a modern vibe.

Chef Carmellini's menu draws on various sources of inspiration: some of his dishes are an ode to a place or to his family history, while others are platonic ideals that have been perfected over the years. The wine program is curated by Master Sommelier **Josh Nadel** and features a unique, comprehensive 1,800-bottle wine list featuring acclaimed Italian, French, American and other worldly producers. The design of Café Carmellini imbues the landmark building's original neoclassical architecture with maximalist style, channeling stately Old New York elegance. Café Carmellini features a welcoming kitchen, an intimate bar, two grand sculptural trees, and balconies offering tête-à-tête dining experiences with a view of the action.

The Portrait Bar

Led by Bar Director and longtime industry veteran **Darryl Chan**, The Portrait Bar is an urbane, wood-paneled retreat where guests can enjoy sophisticated cocktails and snack on elevated bar fare by a carved stone fireplace. You never know who'll you'll run into at The Portrait Bar. In this rich, intimate space inspired by Italian villas, dark wood paneling holds an exceptional art collection which is more than just a collection of portraits—paintings, photographs, drawings—it is a collection of lives and stories.

Chan's cocktail list is a mix of modern and classic variations that evoke a sense of place. The menu is inspired by our collective travels and offers a fun but centered taste of the world. Some highlights include Cebu Island, a modern take on a beautiful day at the beach in the form of a clear cocktail with distinct flavors of coconut and calamansi, while Torino brings together everything that we love most about Italian aperitivo culture, breathing this feeling in the essence of a highball.

ARCHITECTURE & DESIGN

Originally built in 1907 as the Second National Bank, the landmarked building was designed by famed architects McKim, Mead & White, best known as the team behind the original Pennsylvania Station, Columbia University, and the Washington Square Park Arch, among other significant projects.

In 2014, Flâneur Hospitality—an initiative founded by real estate entrepreneur and world traveler **Alex Ohebshalom**—began a thoughtful restoration of the Gilded Age building. Each aspect of The Fifth Avenue Hotel is inspired by Ohebshalom's travels and is designed to encourage discovery and cultivate curiosity while offering a sanctuary of unparalleled comfort, intimacy, and service.

The Fifth's ecclectic interiors were designed by **Martin Brudnizki Design Studio (MBDS)**. Among his numerous accolades, Brudnizki is regularly listed in *House and Garden*'s Top 100 Leading Interior Designers, AD100, *Elle Decor*'s A-List, and Debrett's 500 Most Influential People in the UK.
