



School response if a child/adult displays COVID symptoms during school time.



Positive Test Result: The child/adult must complete the compulsory self-isolation for at least 10 days from the date of the test. The rest of the bubble will close and all children/adult in this bubble will need to undertake 14 days of compulsory self-isolation. If children develop symptoms in this time, they must be tested. School must be informed of the test outcome. If a result is received on a weekend, families **must inform school by 8am on the Monday morning**. School inform Local Public Health team and follow all guidance given.
