



School Uniform

Uniform is worn at Tyntesfield to develop a sense of pride in being a member of our school community and identifies the children with our school. It portrays our school's ethos and shared positive values. We kindly ask that parents support us in ensuring their child wears the correct uniform.

School Uniform
Grey skirt, pinafore dress or grey tailored trousers White shirt with a collar and top button (no open collared shirts) School cardigan or jumper * School tie* In summer, red/white gingham dress or grey tailored shorts may be worn Grey or white socks / grey tights Head scarf (Burgundy/Black/white)

As part of our uniform, the PTA provides a book bag for the Infants. Each child is given one on entry to our school. The bags are made of durable water repellent polyester and are paid for from PTA funds.

As pupils move from Reception to Year 4, the children are to continue to use our school book bags due to safety concerns in the cloak room. As pupils move into Year 5 and 6, they are to provide a small bag/rucksack for their belongings.

Sensible school shoes (black) are required to be worn. No boots are to be worn. No trainers to be worn except for sporting activities.

PE Kit
It is important for pupils to wear correct clothing for physical activities. Plain white T-shirt (T-shirts with the school logo are available) Black shorts Plain maroon sweatshirt for winter months (sweatshirts with the school logo are available) Black tracksuit bottoms for winter months Sports socks Trainers

Jewellery

On health and safety grounds we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school except for ear-ring studs and watches. During PE and games we ask children to remove all items of jewellery. Where it is not possible for the child to remove the jewellery, we ask them to cover them to prevent them from causing injury.
